

:: Access to the Taa language corpus ::

All metadata are open access as is the case for the whole DobeS archive. The Taa corpus contains no totally free accessible media-files. However, a considerable number of files are open for registered users, i.e. people, who have a valid email address and are ready to sign the DobeS Code of Conduct (see http://www.mpi.nl/DOBES/ethical_legal_aspects/DOBES-coc-v2.pdf). This applies to all files under the node 'secondary data' (linguistic and anthropological analysis, summaries, publications and other products) as well as to a number of media files under the node 'primary data' such as fully analyzed texts, non-speech videos showing performances for tourists or photographs. Users are invited to contact the team members in order to arrange access to other resources for certain purposes. Files under the node 'Taa Team Only' are inaccessible to external users because they contain sensitive data such as personal information on speakers.

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
