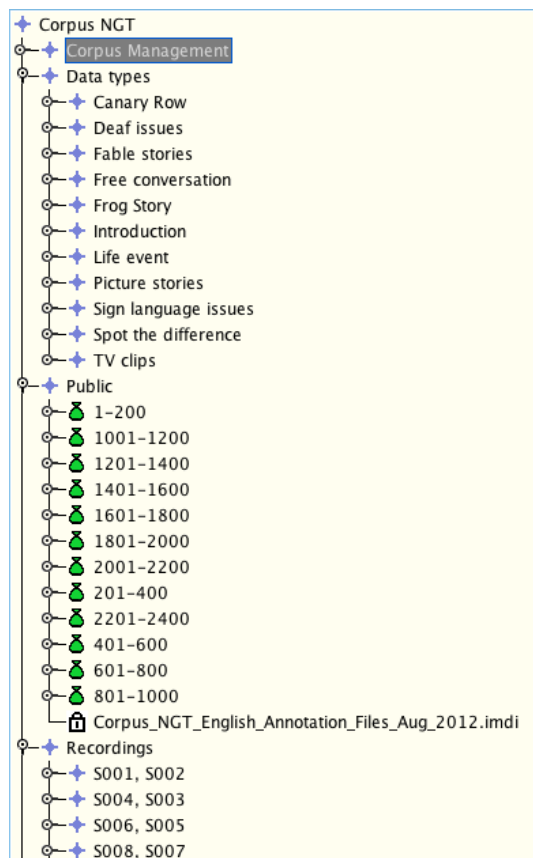


Welcome to the Corpus NGT in The Language Archive

The Corpus NGT consists of 2375 sessions with linked media files and ELAN annotation files (EAF). Most of the sessions are publicly accessible: user 'anonymous' can download data without having to log in. A **Creative Commons BY-NC-SA 3.0** license applies to the use of all data you have access to (more info on the web site below).

The corpus is sorted in three parallel hierarchies: grouped by **Recordings** (signer pair), **Regions**, and **Data Types** (the type of elicitation material that was used). All three hierarchies contain the same information: the metadata session, multiple movie files per signer, and annotation files.



In addition, the node **Public** contains the publicly accessible version of all movies, where the main ('body') view of the two signers have been combined in a single video clip.

The node **Documentation** contains the various versions of the annotation conventions that came with the various releases of the annotations. Older versions of the annotations are available on the web site below, and under the Versions button for each archived file.
